Become a Member

Posner Center Membership is aimed at building a community where Tenants and Members all benefit from increasingly rich relationships and connections, access to shared resources and services, and expanded educational training and skills sharing opportunities. We have several levels of Membership, but becoming an Annual Member (between \$150-250 a year) grants you one free hour of Classroom time each year, and becoming a Monthly Member grants you one free hour per month in a Flex Room. This is also the best way to engage with our community of innovators outside of becoming a Tenant. Become a Tenant

Tenants in our building all receive an allocation of free hours in each of our available common/shared rooms in the building. While allocations vary depending on your seat or office type, this means that your next Board meeting, your next fundraiser, or your next big meeting can happen in our building at no cost as long as you're remaining within your allotted time, and as long as the space you need for an event isn't already booked out by another Tenant. It's first come, first served, but that means no headaches around finding a venue for your next big meeting or event. Community Night

Posner hosts Community Nights once a month, typically on the third Monday of each month from 6-8pm. Because we would like to use our space as an asset to our local community (the Five Points/Curtis Park or surrounding 80205 area), we would like to offer Community Night as an opportunity for our neighbors to host events in our space (nonprofits or community-focused organizations or individuals only). This night can be for several groups at once, or a single group looking to host a specific event. Posner staff must be in attendance to help open and lock-up the building, as well as to help oversee any clean-up or other event logistics for you. Open a Training to Our Tenants

We often host trainings for free when external groups offer the option for our Tenants (and hopefully our Members, as well) to attend for free because this provides a benefit to both them and our mission. We are also willing to work out discounted pricing for Tenants, or pricing structures in which revenue is generated for you and Posner that seem like a win-win for everyone involved, including our Tenants. This is not an opportunity for a consultant solely to pitch their services to our Tenants; rather, only training sessions with an agenda and a demonstrable benefit for our Tenants/ Members will be considered. In addition, this option is not open to any type of event, but to trainings specifically.
