REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- -Lives permanently in Costa Rica. You must already be based in Costa Rica in order to be considered for this position. Candidates applying from abroad will not be considered for this position.
- -Speaks and writes in both Spanish and English with complete fluency. This will be tested.
- -Has experience working remotely and requires little supervision with projects and daily tasks.
- -Is extremely organized and self-motivated.
- -A natural problem solver. You actively work to fix problems without being asked and are constantly looking for ways to improve systems and protocol.
- -Comfortable with budgeting, overseeing in-country finances and ensures all expenses are accurately recorded.
- -You are a natural leader who has experience supervising and overseeing a small team of their own.
- -Has worked with young adults, traveled extensively in Costa Rica, and supports the ideals of community service and cultural exploration.
- -Experienced using CRM systems, QuickBooks, Excel and Google Docs
