#### Who is Alternativ?

Alternativ works to catalyze sustainable economic growth and poverty alleviation through our high-impact entrepreneurial training. ### **Intern Job Description**

Alternativ is looking for a self-starter who will lead a significant project to benefit the organization. Project opportunities include developing and implementing a marketing strategy, leading our refugee program, developing advanced learning modules, or leading a major fundraising initiative. Interns are expected to lead the project with support of Alternativ staff for approximately 75% of their time commitment. The other 25% will be spent helping the organization as needed. Other opportunities are available to help with event planning, corporate sponsorships, and donor profiling. Our aim to provide the Graduate Intern with experience in all the areas they wish to learn. The Graduate Intern qualifies for a stipend if committing a minimum of 300 hours to the internship within 6 months or less.

#### Requirements

An individual passionate about the mission of Alternativ and helping to facilitate sustainable economic growth in the developing world; graduate level expertise in international development, education, or social work, or business; organized self-starter able to work both individually and as part of a team.
