

MANAGING EDITOR FELLOWSHIP POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Posner Center for International Development's mission is to convene, connect, and catalyze the international development community to collaborate for greater impact. We have launched a new effort, the creation of Catalyst, our report on collaborative global development, which helps us to learn from, document, and share best practices in collaborative international development to drive broader change and impact in the sector. Catalyst consolidates the key findings of our annual Symposium as well as other invited contributions to advance the evidence base for global development best practices with a unique focus on collaboration. The report provides a key forum for the Posner Center Community to communicate its work and influence the field of global development.

We are seeking a creative and self-directed Managing Editor Fellow to help us develop our second edition of *Catalyst* and to help lay the foundation for building this report into a peer-reviewed journal. The Fellow will work in close coordination with the Posner Center's Executive Director.

- Help further define the goals and objectives of *Catalyst*
- Develop and coordinate a project timeline for creating and publishing Catalyst
- Evaluate Symposium proceedings for potential *Catalyst* content
- Assist with formatting and drafting sections of Catalyst
- Support Catalyst review processes, including the Editorial Review Board
- Strategize Catalyst sharing and dissemination process
- Identify avenues for *Catalyst* feedback
- Research the process and requirements for developing a peer-reviewed journal
- Identify prospective partners for subsequent year collaborations to produce, review, and disseminate *Catalyst*

- Experience coordinating activities and managing projects in a professional environment
- Academic and professional experience in a related field, such as international development, journalism, communications, political science, or research.
- Excellent English-language writing skills
- Experience producing publications, including editing and desktop publishing a plus

- Interest in understanding collaborative process
- Self-starter, works effectively with high-level direction
- Willingness to try new things, to learn, and to create something new
